Superintendent Austin's service with the National Park Service has been extensive and varied. His duties, which commenced in 1978, have ranged from interpretive park ranger, law enforcement park ranger, and resource management specialist dealing with water quality issues. He has served as a deputy superintendent at Rocky Mountain National Park (Colorado) and Yosemite National Park (California) and as superintendent of the Glen Canyon National Park in Arizona/Utah.

Stan also worked with the United States Environmental Protection Agency for 19 years, eventually being division chief in the Office of Water. Stan spent a year in Japan as a Mike Mansfield Fellow to work with the Japan EPA
